

## Bratton Community Brass Band 100 Club Lottery Rules

## Purpose

The purpose of the band lottery is to raise funds. Money raised from the lottery will be paid into the BCBB bank account and used to help the organisation fund its general operations.

## Rules

- 1. For a cost of £5 per month per number (i.e. per draw) you will be randomly allocated one number. The member will keep that number for the length of time they are in the lottery club.
- 2. A draw will be made on the last Friday of each month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
- 3. The prizes will total 40% of the monthly income. There will be 2% administration fee (card/debit fees). Bratton Community Brass Bands will receive 58% of the income.
- 4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 20%, 2nd prize of 14% and 3rd prize of 6% (of total monthly income). Decimals will be rounded down to whole pounds.
- 5. The band lottery is a small society lottery (registered with Wiltshire County Council) and is open to BCBB Members and Friends of Bratton Bands Members. Anyone aged 16 or over can join the lottery.
- 6. Payments must be made via direct debit monthly via the membership website portal.
- 7. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
- 8. If a member misses a payment, we will assume that member has cancelled their membership, and those number(s) are returned to the lottery pool to be re-assigned.
- 9. Winning payments will be sent via BACs to the members bank account.
- 10. The surname and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on the band's website and social media accounts (unless the winners wish to remain anonymous as indicated on the original Membership Form).
- 11. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into BCBB funds after three months.
- 12. BCBB have the right to cancel the lottery giving 1 months' notice.
- 13. BCBB may increase the number pool at any time, however if the pool is increased, we may add additional prizes.
